

8 VENUE

8.1 The racing area shall be the main body of water of Huntington Lake Reservoir. Detailed map at www.fresnoyachtclub.org .

9 THE COURSES

9.1 The course will be Random Leg Courses, selected from those published and furnished with the registration packet upon skipper check-in.

10 SCORING

10.1 Three (3) races are scheduled, of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 The regatta will be scored as provided in the RRS except that all races will count toward a boat's final score.

10.3 PHRF Fleet Boats will be scored using FYC PHRF Fleet adopted current NCPHRF Ratings, time on time scoring.

10.4 Any Open Class Centerboard (1st Weekend) or Open Keel Class (2nd Weekend) will be scored using the unadjusted D-PN of the current North American Portsmouth Numbers for the respective Class. If a boat racing in the Open Keel Class, cannot be found in the listing and has a PHRF number, the PHRF number for that boat will be converted to Portsmouth as shown in Table V "Relationship of D-PN to PHRF".

11 LAUNCHING, BERTHING, DRY STORAGE

11.1 A launch ramp is available.

11.2 Courtesy berthing is not available. Trespassers may be cited.

11.3 Overnight dry storage is available in the parking area. Please obey parking control. No trailers in the beach area.

12.1 Trophies will be awarded based on class pre-registration.
