As another year approaches an end with another holiday season, let's take a few moments to recap the year for FYC. In January, the membership overwhelmingly approved continuation of racing events during the summer at Huntington Lake, recognizing that our club has the advantage of two venues: Millerton and Huntington. Without a doubt, the events at Huntington this past

summer were more popularly attended than those at Millerton in the spring and fall. There were two significant changes instituted this past year. First, dinner meetings at a popular restaurant were held on Thursdays every other month. Attendance at the dinner meetings in February and April were very well attended, with far better attendance than the Friday meetings held at the Farm Bureau. Second, the membership approved the designation of individuals as Head of Race Committee rather than assigning fleets to race committee responsibilities. To get the policy of designating individuals to head race committees underway, all race committee needs this past year were filled by volunteers. I appreciate all of you who stepped forward to do your part. When the schedule for the upcoming year is set, race participants from this past year who have not yet served as Head of Race Committee are on tap to take their turn. The High Sierra Regatta continued its success as our signature event with a tremendous number of participants and some very complimentary press. The club had several new members this past year, and I'd like to welcome all of you who are new or returning. Generally, I'm thankful for a fruitful year, I've enjoyed the camaraderie with fellow sailors, and I appreciate all the support provided by the vast number of you who helped with club activities this past year. I especially appreciate all the board members agreeing to serve another term in 2007.
