

# FYC CRESENT MOON KEEL BOAT HANDICAP RACE

Revised April 2008

## CLASSES

One Keel Boat Start.

## START FINISH LINE

The start finish will be in the cove N.E. of McKinsey Point in the vicinity of the old mark #8. The first two boats at anchor will constitute the starting line. The line will be between these two boats and extend from them. Once the line has been established participants can take land sightings to determine the finish line upon return.

## COURSE

The course will be around the three floating outhouses (o.h.) or substitute marks anchored on Millerton Lake, in the following sequence:

1. Rhode Island o.h. Starboard
2. Fine Gold Creek o.h. Starboard
3. Winchell Cove o.h. Starboard
4. Finish

In the event any marks are missing, the following are alternates (alt.):

Winchell Cove - alt. = Middle 5 MPH buoy  
Rhode Island o.h. - alt. = Rhode Island  
Fine Gold Creek o.h. - alt. = Middle 5 MPH buoy

## STARTING REQUIREMENTS

Yachts will be at anchored behind the starting line. All crewmembers shall be seated in the cockpit. All headsails will be below deck. Mainsail will be gasketed to the boom. The halyard may be attached. Sheets poles etc. may be on deck.

Any yacht in the starting area, behind the starting line, that cannot or chooses not to comply with the starting requirements, will be scored DNS.

## STARTING

Start time will be 9AM. Official time may be obtained by GPS, Atomic Clock, other automated time systems.

## FINISHING

All participants must record their own finish time. Finish times must be emailed to [info@fresnoyachtclub.org](mailto:info@fresnoyachtclub.org) or given to the Millerton Lake Fleet Captain. In the event that no yacht has finished the race by 3PM, the race will be abandoned.
